

See What Your Money Can Do

Based on 12 pay periods per year, here are just a few examples of the impact you can have within the community around us:

- \$50 per pay period buys two hours of academic tutoring a week for a Native American student, helping them to meet educational testing requirements.
- \$50 per pay period pays for an in-depth investigative report on a critical issue impacting the disability community.
- \$20 per pay period provides 20 youth with a 3-day media and leadership camp to create public service announcements for limited English proficient Asian & Pacific Islanders.
- \$20 per pay period provides 60 youth job seekers with a meal at workshops where they build their resumes, practice interviewing and upgrade their computer skills.
- \$10 per pay period provides 5 homeless patients with needed eyeglasses.
- \$10 per pay period provides a series of three presentations focusing on lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender justice issues which facilitate the dismantling of misconceptions and stereotypes.
- \$10 per pay period provides Internet and digital safety seminars to 40 parents and children.
- \$5 per pay period provides 9 Youth Mentees in the Young Women's Mentoring Program with financial management and leadership training.
- \$5 per pay period provides materials to teach 30 sighted students how blind people read and write.
- \$3 per pay period provides seeds to plant one growing bed for an entire summer.
- \$3 per pay period removes a lead paint hazard on two windows or pays for two energy audits.
- \$2 per pay period underwrites scholarship seats for 20 students to attend a school matinee performance, connecting them with complex societal issues through accessible art.
- \$2 per pay period provides a low-income youth one month of after-school media arts training focused on service-learning projects to benefit the community as a whole.
